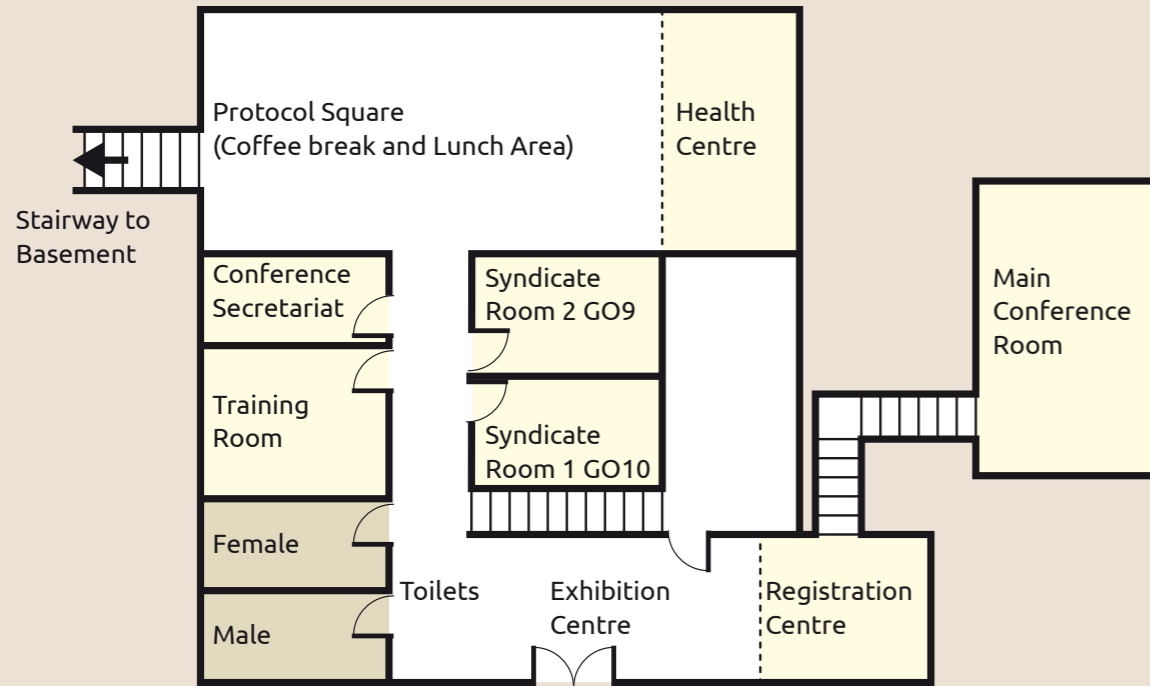

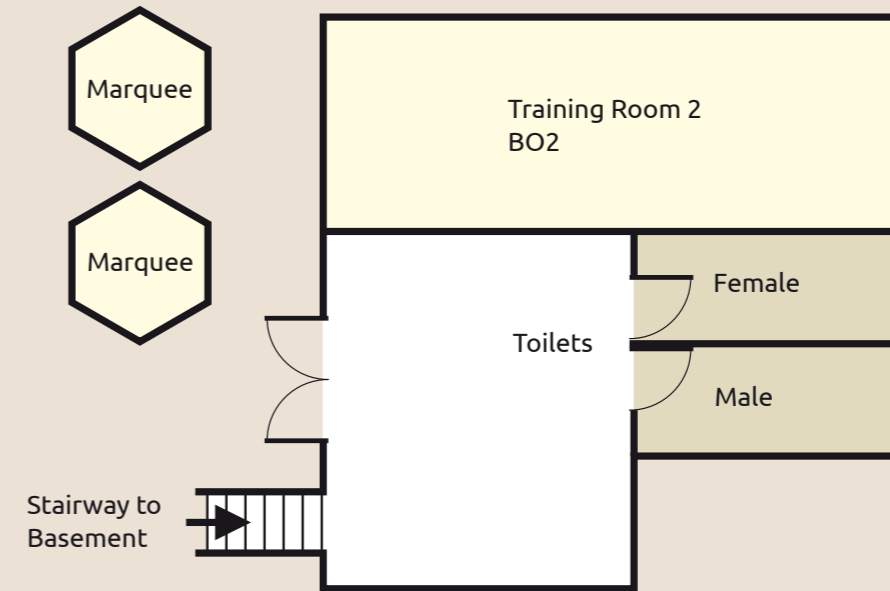

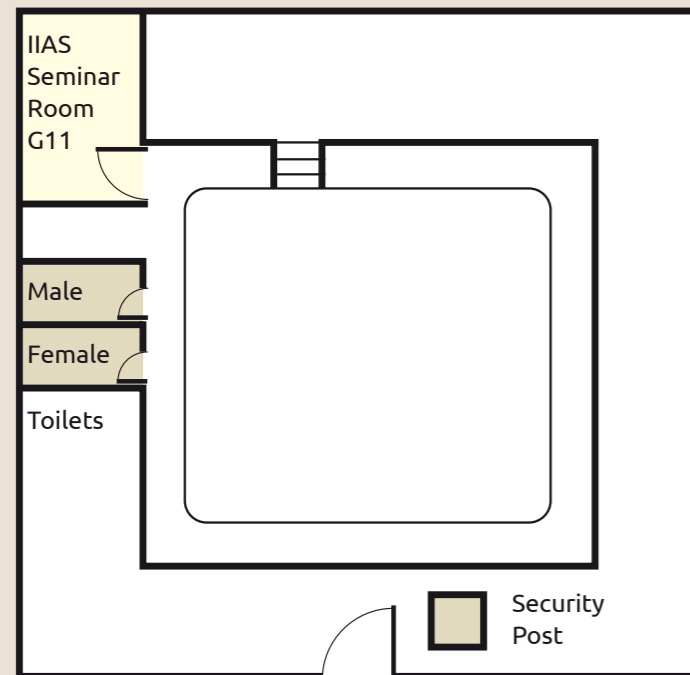


GROUND FLOOR
